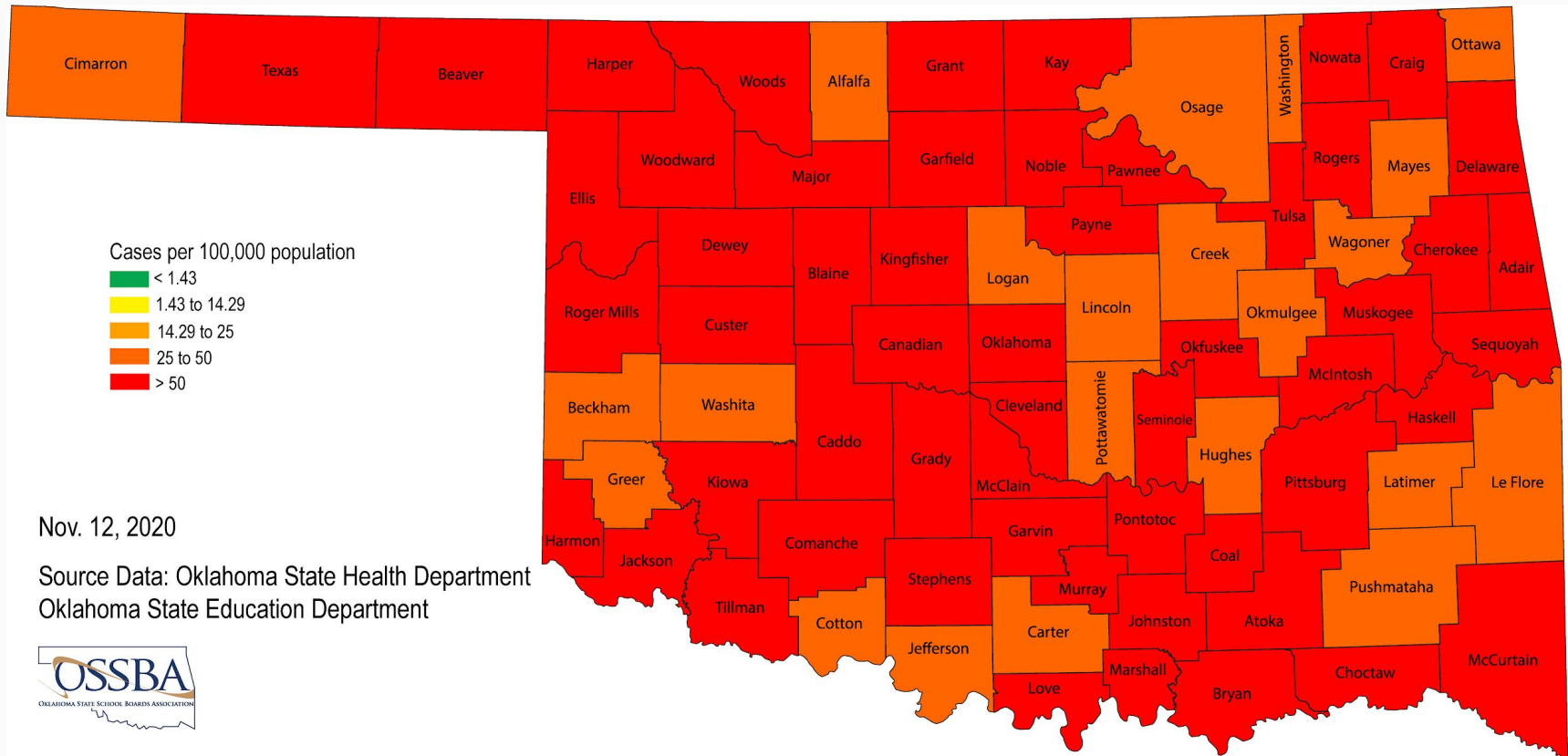

<u>Bixby</u>	<u>15% of HS quarantined as of 11/5; 20% of drivers quarantined</u>	
<u>Broken Arrow</u>	<u>Teacher & bus driver shortages; 54% of teachers absent</u>	
<u>Caney Valley</u>	<u>Teacher shortage</u>	
<u>Collinsville</u>	<u>22% of HS & 11% of district students quarantined</u>	
<u>Dewey</u>	<u>20% of HS quarantined as of 11/9</u>	
<u>Glenpool</u>	<u>Increased student quarantines</u>	
<u>Jenks</u>	<u>Teacher shortage</u>	
<u>Owasso</u>	<u>9-12 DL from 11/18 - 12/18 due to various factors</u>	
<u>Sand Springs</u>	<u>Jump from 26 to 48 isolations (about 1% of pop.)</u>	
<u>Skiatook</u>	<u>Increased isolations & quarantines</u>	
<u>Union</u>	<u>Teacher & bus driver shortages with 19% & 30% quarantined</u>	

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- Prioritized factors in school-wide or district-wide Distance Learning:
 - Ability to staff in-person classrooms with substitute teachers or site staff (sub fill rate)
 - Number and frequency of isolations and quarantines
 - Overall site absenteeism
 - County & city alert status
- Triggers for site or districtwide Distance Learning:
 - Inability to staff classes
 - Indications of a super-spreader
 - Excessive rates of positive cases/quarantines/absenteeism
 - Recommendations from the health department due to extreme conditions

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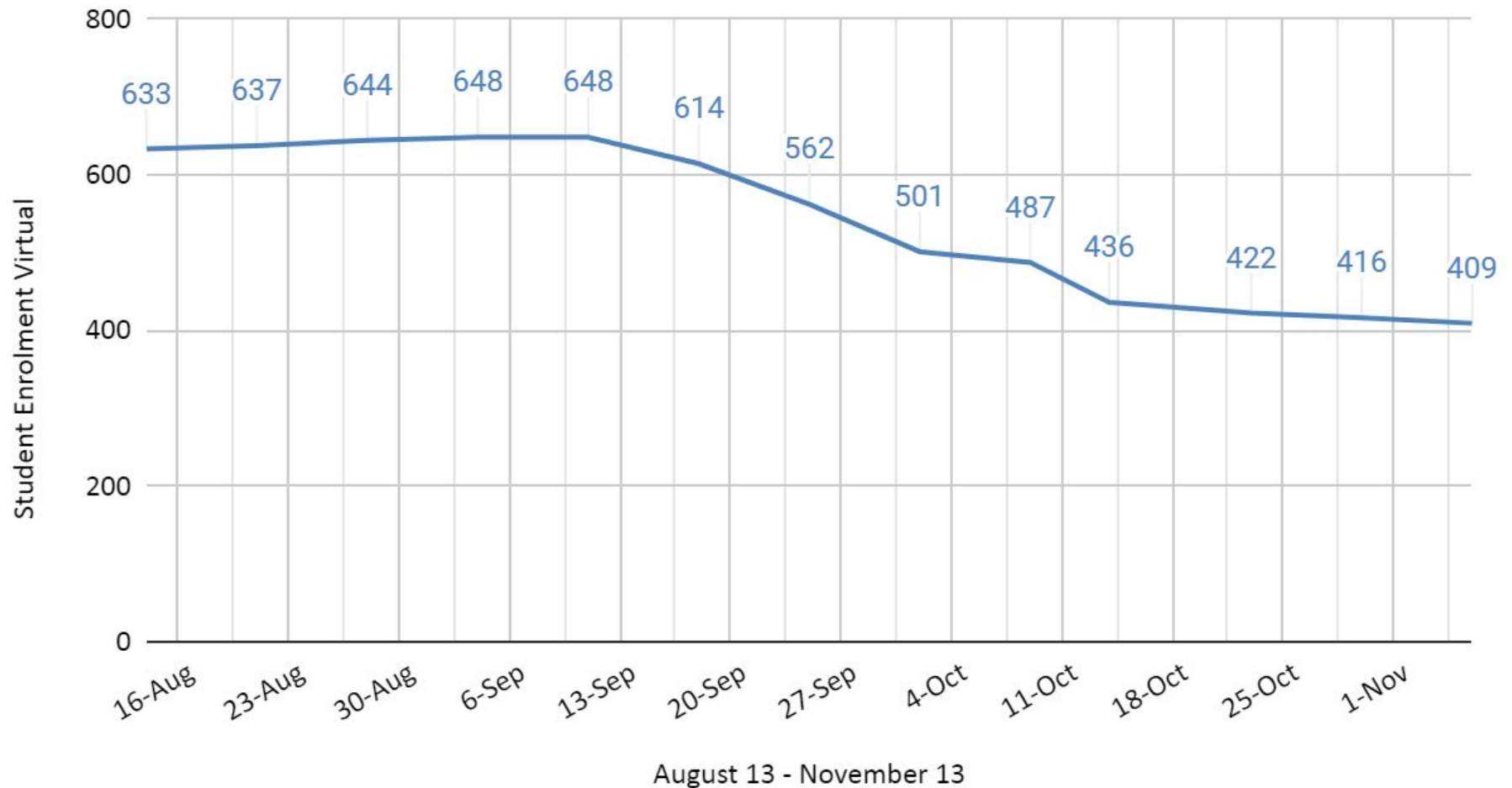
- During extended Distance Learning periods:
 - Students use their Chromebooks at home
 - Teachers and other staff members in suitable job roles and with adequate home internet service could request permission from their supervisors to telecommute; otherwise report to work at assigned site

 - Wilson - **548** (74 virtual=14%)
